Position Title: STEWARDSHIP YOUTH RANGER

Job Term: July 4 to August 25, 2017 - 8 weeks total length

Scheduled Hours of Work: 36.25 hours per week, 7.25 hours per day, at \$11.40/hour

The Stewardship Youth Ranger Program provides youth with the opportunity to work outdoors, learn about environmental issues affecting their community and acquire the valuable skills and work experience needed to launch their future careers.

Purpose: As a Stewardship Youth Ranger (SYR) you will work as part of a team with four Rangers under the direction of one Team Lead with support from Whitesands First Nation and Wabakimi Provincial Park staff. Rangers work on natural resource management projects in the surrounding community. Rangers meet at Whitesands First Nation band office daily. Most projects will be outdoors and could involve rough terrain and a variety of weather conditions.

As a Stewardship Youth Ranger, you will:

- Get hands-on work experience, education and training
- Develop personal and professional skills
- Develop career and community networks

Team Skills:

- You have demonstrated the ability to build and maintain effective relationships working in a team (e.g. at work, at school, in other personal activities) to achieve a common goal
- You have personal leadership skills (e.g. organization skills, accepts responsibility) to initiate and complete tasks in a timely manner
- You have oral communication skills to speak with co-workers, supervisors, members of the public, and media
- You have knowledge, experience and/or interest in natural resource and the outdoors (e.g. work or volunteer experience, school courses, or personal activities)

Mandatory Requirements:

- You must have been born in 2000. This means that applicants may be 16 or 17 at the time of hire, but not turning 18 before December 31, 2017
- You must be a student
- You must be an Ontario resident
- You must be eligible to work in Canada
