



## **Whitesand First Nation Employment Opportunities**

### **Bio-Energy Workforce Development**

Whitesand First Nation is currently underway with site preparation of a Bio-Energy Centre which will host a Wood Merchandising Yard, a 5 Mw Biomass Combined Heat and Power Plant and 90,000 metric ton wood pellet facility.

These facilities will provide substantial employment opportunities within construction, forestry and the operation of the bio-mass facilities for Whitesand, Armstrong and the region. In order to prepare for these opportunities Whitesand First Nation is seeking dedicated and highly skilled people to fill following three positions which will support the development of a Bio-Energy Workforce.

1. **A Workforce Development Coordinator** to map out and develop a multi-pronged bridge training program coinciding with the site preparation, construction, and preparing for operational workforce needs.
2. **A Human Resources Specialist** to provide comprehensive human resources services for a Whitesand First Nation Bio-Energy Corporations, including input into the development of human resources policy, services and programs, and operational plans for the Bio-Energy Corporations.
3. **Community Workforce Liaison** to support the above two positions, coordinate and document community participation, workshops, career fairs, meetings, etc. This position will be based out of Whitesand with travel to Thunder Bay.

These positions are supported by the Ontario Workforce Innovation Centre, Ryerson University and Whitesand First Nation and will begin in October 2017.
