Whitesand First Nation has requested the majority of their staff including council to work from home. There are essential workers however who need to come into the office to provide services or travel to Thunder Bay to collect supplies. Any travel is preapproved and the staff/council are practicing every precaution necessary to stay safe including hand washing or using hand sanitizer after being in the stores, maintaining social distancing, sterilizing surfaces, wearing proper personal protective equipment including gloves and masks when necessary. We are also, when possible are picking up supplies by arranging to have every thing packed and at the back doors of stores to limit staff time in buildings. We also are self monitoring to ensure that we don't have any symptoms.
