COVID-19 PANDEMIC

- ALL monthly benefits will be processed, regardless of suspensions/holds. NO income statements shall be submitted;
- ALL Participation Agreements have been deferred for 60 days, effective March 17th, 2020. NO job searches are required;
- ALL clients and including the members in the benefit unit whom are employed are to submit ALL Earnings to avoid overpayments; Please email payroll to Amanda intake.worker@whitesandfirstnation.com or contact her to make other arrangements for submitting payroll information.
- Clients are to contact Ontario Works Intake, Amanda Doblej by calling the health office 583-2671 and leave a message along with a phone number where you can be contacted.
- Intake Appointments are done over the phone at 583-2671. Amanda will also be assisting those who maybe eligible to apply for the Canada Emergency Response Benefit.
