LOCK DOWN EXTENSION

Based upon information provided by Dr. Douglas (IFNA) regarding the potential of an increase of COVID-19 cases in the area, the lockdown has been extended. The new end date is June 1, 2020 at 11:59 pm. Chief and council would like to thank all of those who are respecting the rules, and doing their part to keep the vulnerable populations such as the elders and people with chronic health conditions safe.

The regular scheduled zones will remain in place. If you do not have an essential errand please do not go out.

Leaving the Community Outside of Your Zone Time

Security must have verification that permission has been granted for someone to leave outside of the regular scheduled zone hours. If it can not be verified you will be asked to return home.

- For permission to go hunting and fishing or for essential needs outside of your scheduled zone time, or other COVID-19 issues please call Brenda at 355-8581

Please be aware that people who chose to leave the reserve without permission may not be readmitted without permission from Chief and Council.

People who continue to disobey the rules outlined in the attached BCR, may be removed from the community through a BCR.

The OPP has been granted permission by the Chief and Council to lay fines/ charges for people not abiding by social gathering and distancing rules.
