The position includes free room and board, and a monthly allowance. Students are expected to be in school during the day and return to Whitesand two weekends per month.

- Prepare nutritious meals (breakfast, dinner)
- Ensure student attendance at school
- Maintain a clean and organized home
- Follow the direction of the education director or designate
- Always ensure the safety and well-being of the students
