## WHITESAND FIRST NATION REAFFIRMED GENERAL ELECTION RULES 2025 (Saturday October 11, 2025 at 11:00 a.m.)

- **1.** Must be Whitesand First Nation Member (Confirmed by Indian Registration Administrator).
- **2.** Must be 18 years of age.
- **3.** Advanced Poll Friday November 14, 2025 Landmark Inn, Thunder Bay, ON located at 1010 Dawson Road from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- **4.** Election Day Saturday November 15, 2025 Multi-plex, Whitesand First Nation, ON from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- **5.** All candidates are eligible to appoint a scrutineer.
- **6.** Indian Registration Administrator can add a member's name to Voters List at Advanced Poll and Election Day.
- 7. No campaigning on the Day of voting (Advanced and Election Day).
- **8.** No loitering permitted in vicinity of polling station(s) including Landmark Inn in Thunder Bay and Whitesand First Nation Multi-plex.
- **9.** Candidates can run for the position of Chief or Councillor, but not both.
- **10.** Translator will be present at advanced poll and election day polling stations.
- **11.** No double-sided ballots.
- **12.** Candidates must be present or provide proxy letter to confirm or decline nominations by the end/close of Nomination meeting on Saturday October 11, 2025 by 4:00 p.m.
- **13.** Candidates will have seven (7) days following the nomination meeting (Saturday October 18, 2025) to withdraw their name as a candidate prior to the printing of the ballot for Chief or ballot for Councillor.
- **14.** Ballots for Chief Candidates and Ballots for Councillor candidates will be printed in accordance with these rules.
